November Guest Artist Rolf Lygren





Rolf Lygren is a native of California. Born in Los Angeles, then moving to Northern California at an early age, his family lived and operated a campground, bait and tackle shop, and marina on a popular lake. Their summers were super busy with the whole family working to operate the resort. Rolf got his early inspiration for painting from his grandmother and mother who took up oil painting in the off-season. Rolf studied painting with Nevin Kempthorne during that time. He also was inspired by the family trips to Carmel-by-the-Sea, and the Monterey Peninsula over Christmas vacations. Visiting Carmel art galleries, seeing the Peter Cost seascape paintings, were among some of his favorite things to do.

"I've always loved art and painting," he said, "I did paint as a teenager, but when I left for college, that was the end of it." Rolf got involved in historical restoration, making furniture, and home building. Then Rolf had an unfortunate construction accident, and his building career came to an end. Rolf's rehabilitation was long, difficult, and it was during that time that he began painting again. "Painting, and



specifically watercolor," says Rolf, "gave my life new direction and purpose."

Rolf completed a Bachelor of Arts degree in Studio Painting from University of California, Santa Cruz. Since the completion of that degree, he has operated out of a studio in Carmel Valley. Rolf has been a part of numerous solo and group shows, he's been juried into the annual Carmel Art Festival for many years running, and Rolf has a nice list of awards for his paintings. His watercolors and oils are in collections up and down the West Coast, from Seattle to San Diego.

Time To Reflect... As An Artist... As A Californian

We were in Paris and started hearing news reports. Fires in northern California! Ok, we're familiar with that. It does happen and, after the long drought and subsequent winter rains, trees were dying and underbrush was growing creating a large amount of fuel. But then we heard about more fires, many in locations that we visit frequently. Many of these locations are where I paint and sketch. This is part of what art is about, illustrating our surroundings and feelings so others can understand what has happened. Yes, there are photographs, but those photographs are not the full story. The story from the artists' perspective is also needed to fill in the blanks.






