October Guest Artist Janet Rogers







Fresh flowers in the studio will be the inspiration for the beginning of this dynamic workshop – progressing to faces and figures. Through a series of "fun" painting exercises, students will develop a more loose and natural approach – giving them an opportunity to be more spontaneous and expressive in their paintings. We will move into painting people, learning how to express translucent flesh tones, while focusing on the gesture of the person. Painting children will also be covered as well as an approach to quickly interpret the figure. Although we will be working primarily with photographs, we may have a chance to work from a model... so bring your camera!

Some students may want to paint just figures or just flowers, although the demonstrations and instruction are geared to beginning with flowers and ending with faces and figures.

Janet will demonstrate her intuitive approach throughout the workshop and work individually with each student, as well as class instruction. "Show and Tell" sessions will be included so that students can see their progression as well as their fellow students. This is always an invaluable tool.

The following Board positions are open for 2018:

Director(s) of National Exhibition

The director of the National Exhibition manages the National Exhibition and acts as board liaison to the National Exhibition committee. This event is a ten-month obligation from beginning to end. The director selects a juror and exhibition site, with concurrence of the Board. The director is responsible for appointing and managing all exhibition committee members. There are numerous departments manned by long term volunteers who continue to work on the National. This is our crowning annual event.

Director(s) of Programs

The Director of Programs is in charge of programs for the general meetings. The director creates the agenda for business portion of general meeting, canvassing board members if they are speaking during business portion of general meeting. They recruit guest artist for general meetings not covered by workshop artist, may consider non-artist event such as art related flea market. They also request artist send promotion material, biography and photos to newsletter editor, confirming receipt with newsletter editor. Several guest artists have already been established for 2018. Act as Board liaison and manage technical support and plein air committee.

Director(s) of Communications

The Communications Director works with the Board to publicize CWA and its activities, manage the publishing of the Newsletter and the actions of the Webmaster. The director will receive all inquiries sent to the email addresses (info@californiawatercolor.org and communications@californiawatercolor.org) and will then pass said inquiries to the proper Board, committee, or staff person. They will promote all events and activities involving CWA that would be of interest to the public to online media websites and other art organizations via their newsletters or websites 2 months' prior for workshops and 4 weeks for other events. Upload information and images including general meeting demonstrations, shows, exhibits, outreach, receptions and any other activities, which will promote CWA to social media. Assist in the compilation and final approval of printed materials.



After about two miles turn right on Oak Grove Road, then bear right onto Castle Rock Road and follow it to the Orchard Staging Area (parking lot) on the right. The Equestrian Center is on the left, and the parking lot is on the right. 
