
Scenery

- -Historic John Muir Home, mature trees, sloping hillside
- -Martinez Adobe and Museum, built in 1849, located in the back of the park
- -Windmill, carriage house, farm equipment, fruit trees, creek

Directions

From San Francisco: Take I-80 East to Highway 4 East. Exit at Alhambra Ave in Martinez. Turn left at the bottom of the ramp. Cross beneath Highway 4. The park is immediately on your left.

From San Jose: Take I-680 North or (from Sacramento south) to Highway 4 West. Exit at Alhambra



Ave. Turn right at the bottom of the ramp. The park is immediately on your left.
